- [1] Motion by the Receiver for an AVO and an Ancillary Order. The motion is unopposed.
- [2] The AVO is granted. The sale process conducted by the Receiver meets the *Soundair* factors and the transaction represents the best recovery available for the property.
- [3] The relief in the Ancillary Order is granted. The 10% holdback for the construction liens is in accordance with s 22(1) of the *Construction Act* (Ontario). It is not opposed by the lien claimants. The activities and fees are approved.
